Kindergarten News

Unit Theme:

Animals in their Homes & Community Workshop

Language Arts/Reading

<u>Phonemic Awareness</u> — Students will put multiple sounds together to make new words. Students will break apart the sounds in words with 4 or more sounds. Students will identify and produce rhyming words.

<u>Phonics</u> —Students will read stories by blending all sounds in words and using sight words learned. Sight words: where, for, how. Review sounds: mm, gg, ll, ck, ff, dd, ss

<u>Literature</u> — Students will listen to a story and discuss story elements. We will identify important story elements and then compare and contrast characters from similar stories.

<u>Writing</u> — Students will focus on narrative writing, writing to tell about events in a story and how they relate to their own lives.



Students will focus on addition to 10, then we will begin building groups of 10. This will prepare us for making numbers in the teens and counting up to 100 by 1s and 10s!

Social Studies/Science

Students will continue to use all the information we have learned about our communities, needs and wants, money and working together to create a community in our classroom. We will work to create shops, tell how much each item should be, which items would be needs/wants and interacting with each other to trade items for coins. We will also discuss the habits of animals in their environment and how they search for food.
