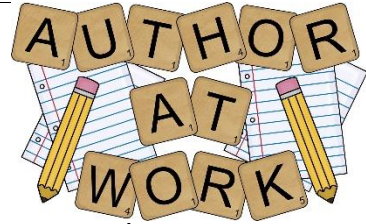


# Kindergarten News

Unit Theme:

## Poetry



March 26-29, 2018

### Language Arts/Reading

Phonemic Awareness – Students will put multiple sounds together to make new words. Students will break apart the sounds in words with 4 or more sounds. Students will identify and produce rhyming words.

Phonics – Students will read stories by using picture clues, blending all sounds in words and using sight words learned.

Literature – Students will listen to poems and identify rhyming words. Students will work in small groups to create their own poems.

Writing – Students will write to tell about their opinions of poems.

Things to work on at home with your child:

- Practice writing sentences about books you read at home
- Counting to 100 by ones and tens
- Read with your child every night and discuss the stories you've read.
- Practice writing numbers 0-20

### Math

Students will focus on making groups of ten and more to create teen numbers.

### Social Studies/Science

Students will continue to use all the information we have learned about our communities, needs and wants, money and working together to work in a community in our classroom. Students will shop for needs and wants, identify the correct coins they need to shop and visit multiple shops, having respectful encounters with their peers.


