Kindergarten News

Unit Theme:

Poetry

Language Arts/Reading

<u>Phonemic Awareness</u> — Students will put multiple sounds together to make new words. Students will break apart the sounds in words with 1 or more sounds. Students will identify and produce rhyming words.

<u>Phonics</u> —Students will read stories by using picture clues, blending all sounds in words and using sight words learned.

<u>Literature</u> — Students will listen to poems and identify rhyming words. Students will work in small groups to create their own poems. <u>Writing</u> — Students will write to tell about their opinions of poems.

Math

Students will focus on making groups of ten and more to create teen numbers.

Social Studies/Science

Students will continue to use all the information we have learned about our communities, needs and wants, money and working together to work in a community in our classroom. Students will shop for needs and wants, identify the correct coins they need to shop and visit multiple shops, having respectful encounters with their peers.
