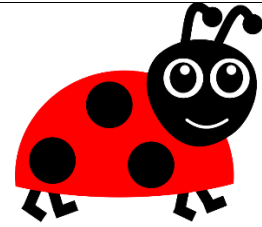


Kindergarten News

Unit Theme:

Ladybug Life-Cycles



April 16-20, 2018

Language Arts/Reading

Phonemic Awareness – Students will put multiple sounds together to make new words. Students will blend sounds to make new words.
Phonics – Students will read stories by using picture clues, blending all sounds in words and using sight words learned.
Literature – Students will listen to non-fiction and fiction texts. We will focus on telling the information in a sequential order and on fiction vs non-fiction. We will also discuss WHY the author wrote the books.
Writing – Students will write to tell about the details from the texts. Focus on informational and narrative writings.

Things to work on at home with your child:

- Practice writing sentences about books you read at home
- Counting to 100 by ones and tens
- Read with your child every night and discuss the stories you've read.
- Practice writing numbers 0-20
- Build teen numbers with a group of 10 and more.

Math

Students will continue to focus on counting groups to 20 and counting to 100 by 10s and 1s.

Social Studies/Science

Students will sequence information in a lifecycle to show the progression over time. We will discuss Earth Day and the effect recycling has on our earth.
